

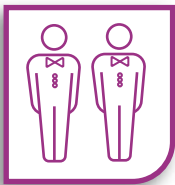


Are you married or in a civil partnership?

Everything passes to your spouse or civil partner.

Is your estate worth more than £270,000?

Everything is shared equally between your children. If a child dies before the intestate, their children will inherit in their place, each sharing their parent's entitlement in equal parts.



Everything passes to your spouse or civil partner (including property) up to £270,000 in total value, as well as half of the remainder of your estate. The other half is shared equally between your surviving children or grandchildren (if children die before the intestate).

Do you have children or grandchildren?

Everything is shared equally between your parents.

Do you still have siblings or half siblings?

Everything is shared equally between your brothers and sisters or half-brothers and half-sisters. If a sibling dies before the intestate, their children will inherit in their place, each sharing their parents entitlement in equal parts.

Are your grandparents alive?

Everything is shared equally between your surviving grandparents.



Do you have any aunts or uncles?

Everything is shared equally between your surviving aunts or uncles. Your half aunts or uncles will then be entitled to your estate. If they have already died, their children will inherit in their place.
